

## 6 APRIL 2010

### CRAIGLUSCAR, DUNFERMLINE

1.00 PM - 5.00 PM

4 miles **Grade 2**

We visit Craigluscar Community Woodland in Springtime for some great views across the Forth Valley and Fife.

## 20 APRIL 2010

### FALKLAND ESTATE

9.00 AM - 5.00 PM

7 miles **Grade 3** **Transport £9.00**

A walk from Falkland up Maspie Den with its impressive waterfall, then up to the Tyndall Bruce Monument, returning via Arratay Craigs.

## 4TH MAY 2010

### MENSTRIE GLEN

1.00 PM - 5.00 PM

5 miles **Grade 3**

Initially a steep climb which becomes an undulating track as far as Lossburn reservoir. There we cross the burn and return via Menstrie Glen.

## 18 MAY 2010

### BLAIRGOWRIE

9.00 AM - 5.00 PM

7 miles **Grade 2** **Transport £9.00**

We head up and alongside the river Ericht before returning to the western outskirts of Blairgowrie following the Ardblair trail and passing through Bluebell Wood.

## 1 JUNE 2010

### ALYTH

9.00 AM - 5.00 PM

7 miles **Grade 2** **Transport £9.00**

Nestling at the foot of several peaks in the hills north of Alyth, the Backwater Reservoir offers a very varied circular walk.

## 15 JUNE 2010

### CORB GLEN/JOHN'S HILL

1.00 PM - 5.00 PM

3½ miles **Grade 3**

Undulating open track up Corb Glen followed by a steep climb to the summit of John's Hill. Descent over tussocky, peaty ground, with some marshy patches, to rejoin the outward route.

## 29 JUNE 2010

### UPPER LARGO TO LEVEN

9.00 AM - 5.00 PM

6.5 miles **Grade 1** **Transport £9.00**

A woodland walk through Keil's Den, then down to Lower Largo and along the Fife Coastal Path to Leven.

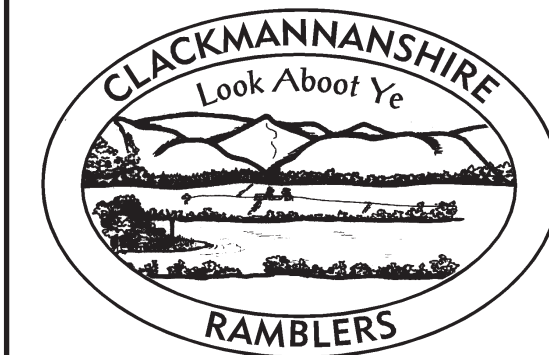

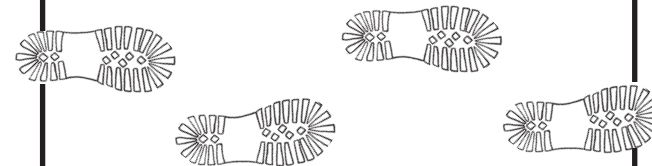

**15 SEPTEMBER 2009**

**CAMBUS**

1.00 PM – 5.00 PM

6 miles **Grade 1**

Take a walk along the banks of the River Forth and explore the wetlands to find out what they have to offer in September.

**29 SEPTEMBER 2009**

**KINGS BARNES TO CRAIL**

9.00 AM – 5.00 PM

6 miles **Grade 1** **Transport £9.00**

An open, spacious and atmospheric walk with many points of interest both on shore and sea.

**13 OCTOBER 2009**

**GARTMORN**

10.00 AM – 4.00 PM

8 miles **Grade 2**

A circular local walk, starting and finishing at Gartmorn Dam, via Linn Mill, Slack and Forestmill.

**27 OCTOBER 2009**

**BOCHASTLE AND THE FALLS OF LENY**

10.00 AM – 4.00 PM

5 miles **Grade 2**

The walk uses forest tracks and paths on the lower slopes of Ben Ledi. The descent is on the lower half of the Ben's track to come down to the old railway line alongside the River Teith.

**10 NOVEMBER 2009**

**GRANDTULLY TO ABERFELDY**

9.00 AM – 5.00 PM

5-7 miles **Grade 1 & 2** **Transport £9.00**

The walk follows the line of the old railway and a new path alongside the Tay (5 miles). At Aberfeldy there will be options of ascending part of the Birks (grade 1) or going all the way to the Falls of Moness (grade 2, 1 mile each way).

**24 NOVEMBER 2009**

**DOLLAR VICARS BRIDGE**

1.00 PM – 4.00 PM

4 miles **Grade 2**

A easy walk for this time of year along rights of way and quiet country roads through Pitgobet to Vicars Bridge on the River Devon.

**8 DECEMBER 2009**

**CHRISTMAS DO**

1.00 PM – 4.00 PM

**Grade 4+**

Alloa Town Hall. An opportunity to give your feet a well-earned rest!

**12 JANUARY 2010**

**HAWKCRAG POINT, ABERDOUR**

11.00 AM – 3.00 PM

5 miles. **Grade 2**

This walk follows the Fife Coast including Silversands Beach. Views of the Firth of Forth. Returning on higher ground through the woods known as the Heughs.

**26 JANUARY 2010**

**CROOK OF DEVON AND RUMBLING BRIDGE**

11.00 AM – 3.00 PM

4.5 miles. **Grade 2**

Starting from the Crook, the walk follows the river Devon towards Naemoor and returns by the spectacular Rumbling Bridge and the Broom Road.

**9 FEBRUARY 2010**

**MONTROSE BAY**

9.00 AM – 5.00 PM

7.5 miles **Grade 2** **Transport £9.00**

A circular walk commencing with a 3-mile stretch along this beautiful blue flag beach, and including a riverside ramble.

**23 FEBRUARY 2010**

**GLENSHERUP AND BEN SHEE**

1.00 PM – 5.00 PM

4.5 miles **Grade 2 & 4**

Starting from the Glensherup car park we follow the "Reservoir Trail" by the River Devon as far as Frandy Farm. Here the grade 2 walkers return along the same path. The grade 4 walkers continue on a circular route via Ben Shee.

**9 MARCH 2010**

**BISHOP HILL**

9.00 AM - 5.00 PM

6 miles **Grade 2**

A linear walk rising gradually through farmland, forestry plantings and disused limestone quarries. The last leg is somewhat steeper, but short in length.

**23 MARCH 2010**

**ROSLIN**

9.00 AM – 5.00 PM

7 miles **Grade 3** **Transport £9.00**

A circular walk, with historical interest, via Dryden Tower, Bilston Viaduct and Roslin Glen, with a number of steep ascents and descents. Some muddy sections likely.
